

- a. armed and non-armed aerial drones,
- b. satellite coverage;
- 2. <u>Calls for</u> every neighbouring country of Nigeria to shut down their borders so that the international community has control over the movement out of and into Nigeria;
- 3. <u>Decides</u> that all member countries are allowed to launch short-time military actions in order to save citizens of their country for the next six months;
- <u>Declares</u> that in the current situation a great breach of international security occured and that the Security Council will take measures as laid out in Chapter VII of the UN Charta;
- 5. <u>Asks</u> all neighbouring countries to work together with the international alliance and to allow international military forces and humanitarian organizations to use their country as a base;
- 6. <u>Calls for</u> military support by the members of the United Nations in order to destroy Boko Haram and save the citizens of Nigeria.
