**Question of:** Boko Haram taking over Nigerian military

The Security Council

1. **Calls for** an immediate joint effort to gain intelligence on the movements and positions of the terrorist occupants in Nigeria as well as the Nigerian army, by means such as but not limited to
  - a. armed and non-armed aerial drones,
  - b. satellite coverage;
2. **Calls for** every neighbouring country of Nigeria to shut down their borders so that the international community has control over the movement out of and into Nigeria;
3. **Decides** that all member countries are allowed to launch short-time military actions in order to save citizens of their country for the next six months;
4. **Declares** that in the current situation a great breach of international security occurred and that the Security Council will take measures as laid out in Chapter VII of the UN Charter;
5. **Asks** all neighbouring countries to work together with the international alliance and to allow international military forces and humanitarian organizations to use their country as a base;
6. **Calls for** military support by the members of the United Nations in order to destroy Boko Haram and save the citizens of Nigeria.
