

Presidential Statement (Crisis Resolution)

At the 19th meeting of the Security Council, held on 20 May 2019, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "Venezuela – Tackling a Humanitarian, Economic and Political Crisis" and in connection with rapidly changing situation at the Venezuelan – Columbian boarder, the presidency made the following statement on behalf of the council:

1.	Condemns Maduro's order to stop the convoys, delivering emergency relief to Vene-
	zuela;

- 2. **Urges** all parties involved in the situation to come to a ceasefire agreement, including the condition of disarmament of the Venezuelan military;
- 9 3. Stresses that in case of Venezuela violating the ceasefire agreement, Venezuela will
 have to face military intervention by troops of UN member countries, within a UN
 peacekeeping mandate, led by a UN command;
- Invites the responsible head of the military forces of Venezuela, President Maduro,
 Mister Guaido and an international, neutral contact group sent from the United Na tions, lead by the presidency of the Security Council, to discuss the current escalation
 of the situation and how to solve it in order to ensure peace and stability.
