Question of: Tackling the Terroristic Surge in Burkina Faso

1 The Security Council, 2 3 Alarmed by the murder of the President of Burkina Faso, urgent action is needed to keep residents and leaders safe from further terrorist attacks, 4 5 6 Fully aware of the instability in the Sahel Region caused by extremist groups, such as Boko 7 Haram, 8 Fully alarmed by the negative effects on international security that results from the increase in 9 territory in control by terrorist groups, 10 11 Expecting urgent actions and help, in regard to all the demands the Security Council makes, 12 13 14 Has deep condolences for the death of the President of Burkina Faso and supports the re-15 maining family of the President in these trying times, 16 17 1. <u>Strongly condemns</u> the assassination of the President of Burkina Faso; 18 2. Decides on a peacekeeping mission, sending in Blue Helmets for the protection of 19 20 Burkina Faso and the neighboring G5 Sahel countries, their leaders and civilians; 21 3. Requests the governments of Burkina Faso, Mali, and the neighboring G5 Sahel coun-22 tries to closely and strictly monitor the borders in the time of searching the terrorist 23 group and neutralizing the threat by: 24 a. urging Mali and the neighboring G5 countries to stop air traffic with any other 25 country. 26 b. encouraging the government to share any information regarding the terrorists 27 with other countries immediately to make the search for the terrorists most effi-28 29 cient: 30 31 4. Decides to mobilize the armies of the Sahel Region to search and eliminate the terrorist group responsible for the assassination of the President of Burkina Faso; 32 33 34 5. Requests for all United Nations member states to share their intelligence of the actions and whereabouts of the terrorist organizations to: 35 a. find their headquarters and hideouts, which shall then be shared across the 36 37 United Nations and G5 Sahel forces, b. improve coordination between all armed forces in the region, 38 allow warning civilians and governments early, which shall give them enough 39 C. time to evacuate or build up defenses to minimize causalities and further insta-40 bilities; 41 42

- 43 6. <u>Urges</u> all member states to send humanitarian aid to the Sahel Region immediately,
  44 which shall help injured civilians, armed forces and politicians and help stabilize the
  45 humanitarian situation in the Sahel Region;

- 47 7. <u>Urges</u> the United Nations to step up its cooperation with the African Union, in order to combat and stop terrorism in the Sahel Region, and in particular in Burkina Faso;
- 50 **8.** <u>Strongly suggest</u> that civilians and politicians find a safe place to stay.
