



- 1 The UN Women Committee,

3 *Acknowledging* that women have equal rights in a lot of countries by law,
4
5 *Noting with regret* that there is still inequality in the economic and social sector,
6
7 *Deeply concerned* about the lack of sexual education and menstruation products
8 being accessible to women,
9
10 *Reaffirming* abortion rights strengthen the self determination of women,
11
12 *Alarmed by* seeing many countries with laws against abortions and against the right
13 of choice,
- 14 1. **Supports** the legalization of Abortion for pregnant women until the third month:
15 a. The third month rule can be extended in the cases of
16 i. Rape,
17 ii. A dead fetus,
18 iii. A life-endangerment of the mother,
19 iv. A severe mental or physical illness of the mother;

- 22 2. **Encourages** lowering the taxes on
23 a. Menstruation products,
24 b. Medical care for women
- 25 3. **Recommends** the formation of a hotline so the women that have to go
26 through pay gap can call and report the companies or get help:
27 a. The hotline will be controlled and checked by a subcommittee in the UN
28 Women Committee,
29 b. Information will be stored in need of investigation:
30 i. The caller will be informed at the beginning of the call that it will
31 be recorded,
32 ii. The reported company will be investigated by a sub-committee if
33 the caller wants,
34 iii. The caller will be able to call anonymously,
35 iv. The caller will be able to ask for help or get information about
36 the pay gap;

4. **Considers** the formation of a group under the UN Women Committee specifically on pay-gap:
 - a. That will specify on this issue,
 - b. That will control and store the information for the formed hotline,
 - c. That will have international psychologists and UN workers;

 5. **Encourages** the schools to encourage the self determination of females:
 - a. Encourages schools to provide menstruation products in school/workplaces for free, for example:
 - i. Sanitary towels,
 - ii. Tampons,
 - b. Suggests offering accessible information on sex education and menstruation for any gender:
 - i. Books for different ages,
 - ii. Made by a group of the UN Women Committee that consists of people that are experienced in the topic of women’s health and sex education including psychologists,
 - iii. Inform and raise awareness about the stereotypes about women;

 6. **Draws the attention** to representing women in leading roles to ensure equal representation of interests:
 - a. The delegates that submit the resolution try to enforce a “gender quota law” of 25% in their countries;

 7. **Considers** organizing a forum that will discuss the unequal rates of women in countries and what should be done:
 - a. NGOs will be invited,
 - b. All countries will be invited,
 - c. The countries that decide to participate in the forum will be provided with economic resources in the case that they plan a project to decrease these rates;

 8. **Decides** to remain actively seized on the matter.
